Children should be encouraged to wear helmets when cycling to school.

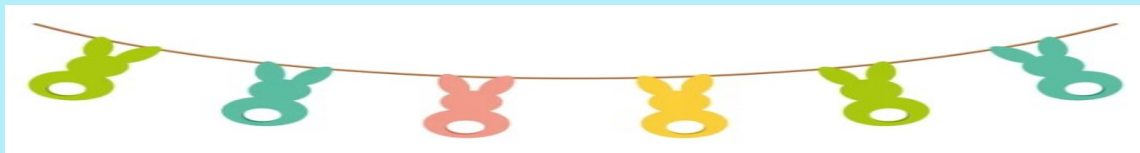
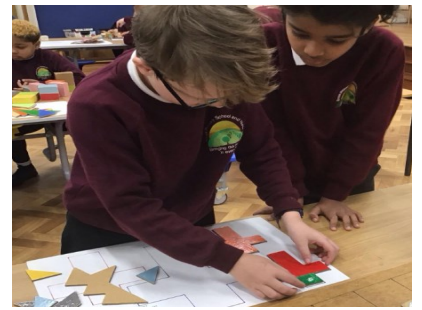
All children should walk their bikes when on the school grounds to prevent accidents.
