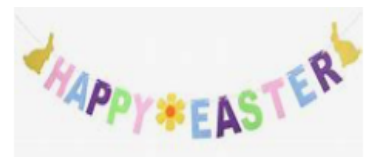

The children and staff have welcomed a number of visitors recently. Last week, Mrs. Howard and Mrs. Baldwin conducted a Teaching and Learning review on behalf of the Local Authority. During the morning, Miss Dixon and I shared the ongoing work for the Grove Curriculum and discussed the School Development Plan. Mrs. Bilke joined us as we scrutinized standards in Writing across the school.
