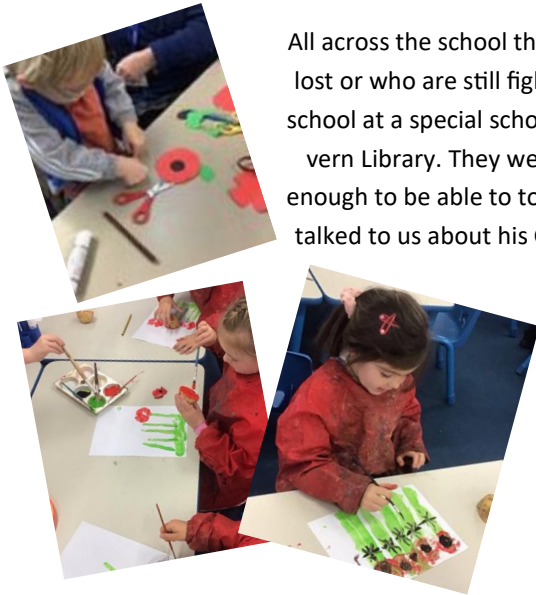


ATTENDANCE INFORMATION
